# LaVergne Middle School

### "Retake-Redo Policy"

#### This policy is strictly optional.

#### Ultimate Goal:

To see students perform best on their first attempt on any assignment, projects, or assessments, given appropriate study techniques, practices, and efforts have been best utilized.

#### **Rationale:**

Not all students will master the standards/skills the first time around. As a result, students must take ownership of their actions to reflect on practices and seek to complete review exercises before a second attempt (only once) is granted. This policy provides for additional time and support, parental involvement and student choice.

#### Procedure: Retake (Assessments only)

- 1. Students must request permission to attend "Opportunity Lab" to Retake an Assessment.
- 2. Parent acknowledgment form must be signed and returned before student is permitted to attend.
- 3. Student must complete two practice assignments with teacher approval before "Retake" can be granted.
- 4. Student must have Retake Task or Assignment in hand upon entry to the lab.
- 5. Retake must be sought after and completed within 4 days of the first attempt the graded paper is returned.
- 6. "Opportunity lab" is only before or after school hours.

#### Procedure: Redo (Class assignments)

- 1. Students must request permission to attend "Opportunity Lab" to Redo an Assignment.
- 2. Parent acknowledgment form must be signed and returned.
- 3. Student must request time during "Advisory- with teacher" to complete Redo assignment. Assignment must be completed during this time on that day.
- 4. Redo must be sought after and completed within 2 days of the first attempt graded paper is returned.

#### Criteria: (One Attempt Chance)

- 1. Any student can Retake an Assessment for a better grade.
- Any student can Redo an Assignment if grade is lower than a 70. Highest possible Redo grade will be recorded. If student did not turn in the assignment on the first original attempt, highest possible grade recorded will be an 80.

#### Extensions:

Students with an IEP, ESL or Tier III (those receiving services from Interventionist) will be given two attempts. Criteria and Procedures remains the same.

\*\*\*\*If a pattern of behavior is recognized, a parent conference must be set up by the teacher.

## \*\*\*\*Teacher will post new grade within 48 hours of submission.
